OCLC announced plans to discontinue support for previous software.

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* L

* Search &
* Email,
* Answer &
* Loan

- * A virtual union catalog (VUC) using Z39.50 standards
- * Searching for material and requesting from a library in the Southeastern region
- * Following regional ILL protocols for borrowing and lending

* What will stay the same?

Previous version

- * System built routing list called a rota
- * Dual procedures in SEAL and your circulation system
- * Complex with many buttons

New version of SEAL

- * Email request goes to one location only
- * Keep track of loaned items via your library's circulation system
- * Fewer steps

* What is different?

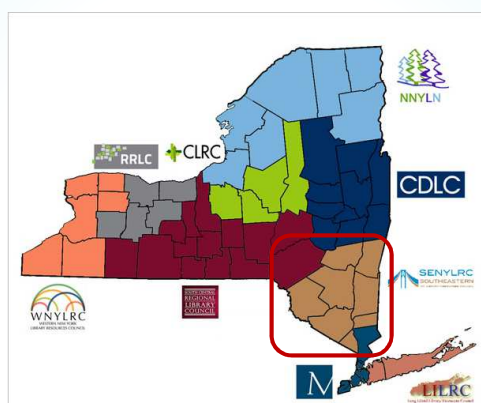

*Timeline

- *Folders in your email program
- *Few requests? Paper trail
- *Consider how you will handle patron names
- *Queues of requests available in your account
- *Checkout to patrons in your circ system
- *Checkout to other libraries in your circ system

*Management of SEAL requests

- *Your circ system should generate overdue notices to patrons and for books loaned to other libraries
- *Respond to overdue notices from other libraries quickly

*Overdues

*Call or email the lender for a renewal

*Renewals

*Enter questions now into the text box.
